Tartu – the main University town & European Capital of Culture 2024



- + Capital of Southern Estonia, Estonia's 2nd largest city
- + the oldest city in Baltic States
- + thriving hub of culture and innovation

- + Tartu University (1632), ranking among 1% best universities in the world
- + Magnet for conferences, particularly those related to scientific and medical fields
