Tallinn Official Sightseeing Tour

Duration: 2,5 hours (1 hour by bus, 1,5 hours walking tour)

Exciting adventure on the streets of Tallinn's Old Town.

Tallinn is still a relatively undiscovered city. The visitors are amazed by it's historic ambiance with Medieval walls, Gothic churches and cobblestone streets, at the same time the latest high-tech conveniences always at hand. It's this combination of old and new, Medieval and modern, quiet and green, that gives Tallinn its unique flavor.







The bus tour passes through the baroque Park Kadriorg, Song Festival Grounds and the seaside district of Pirita. The introduction to the old town begins with a brief history of Estonia and Tallinn and continues with visits to the most interesting and significant sites of Lower and Upper Old Town, each with their own story to tell.

Admire the picturesque Lower Town, the fortified medieval Town Wall with many towers, the impressive over 600 year old Gothic Town Hall, the Town Hall Square and Town Council Pharmacy, which is the oldest continuously functioning pharmacies in the Europe. The path will bring you to the Upper Town, known as Toompea. Here you can take a look at the elaborately decorated Alexander Nevsky Cathedral — the largest Orthodox church in the city, the Houses of Estonian Parliament and one of the oldest churches in Estonia the Dome Church. Experience the magnificent panoramic views from Toompea Hills over the Lower Town and the rest of the city of Tallinn.

Visit to Seaplane Harbor

Seaplane Harbour in Tallinn is one of the most unique maritime museums in Europe with a display comprising of over two hundred large exhibits. Legends here come to life. The tour is on dry land, conducted from the hangar floor, but the stories come from below the waves, the ocean surface, and the world above the sea.

Art Tour of Tallinn

Walking tour in Tallinn Old Town

Living History in Rocca al Mare Open Air Museum

Just a short pleasant drive from the Old City you will be introduced to the past of Estonia. The museum gathers a fine collection of 17th/19th century rural architecture from all over the Estonia. Just like in a proper village, here is a church (1699), an inn, a schoolhouse, several mills, a fire station and net sheds by the sea — altogether 72 buildings. Your guide will turn history into lively scenes as you



visit some of these buildings, all surrounded by beautiful forests and the waterfront.

Tallinn Old Town Walking Tour & Medieval Beer Tasting

Sip by sip you will come to understand why beer is considered by locals a truly holy drink.



Arvo Pärt Centre Visit

There are few composers in music history that have created music using their original composition technique, or whose sound language is so unmistakably recognisable from the very first bars. Arvo Pärt is one such composer, his oeuvre has left an important mark in the history of 20th-century music.



The Arvo Pärt Centre combines the composer's personal archive with an information and music centre. It is an open meeting place for musicians, researchers and music lovers—for anyone interested in Arvo Pärt's music and world of ideas. It was founded by Arvo Pärt and his family, with the aim of creating opportunities for preserving and researching the creative heritage of the composer in the context of his native language in Estonia. The centre is situated in Laulasmaa, 35 kilometres from Tallinn, on a peninsula with magnificent natural surroundings—in a pine forest near the sea.



The Arvo Pärt Centre, designed by architects Fuensanta Nieto and Enrique Sobejano, was awarded the Grand Prix of the Cultural Endowment for Architecture in 2019.


