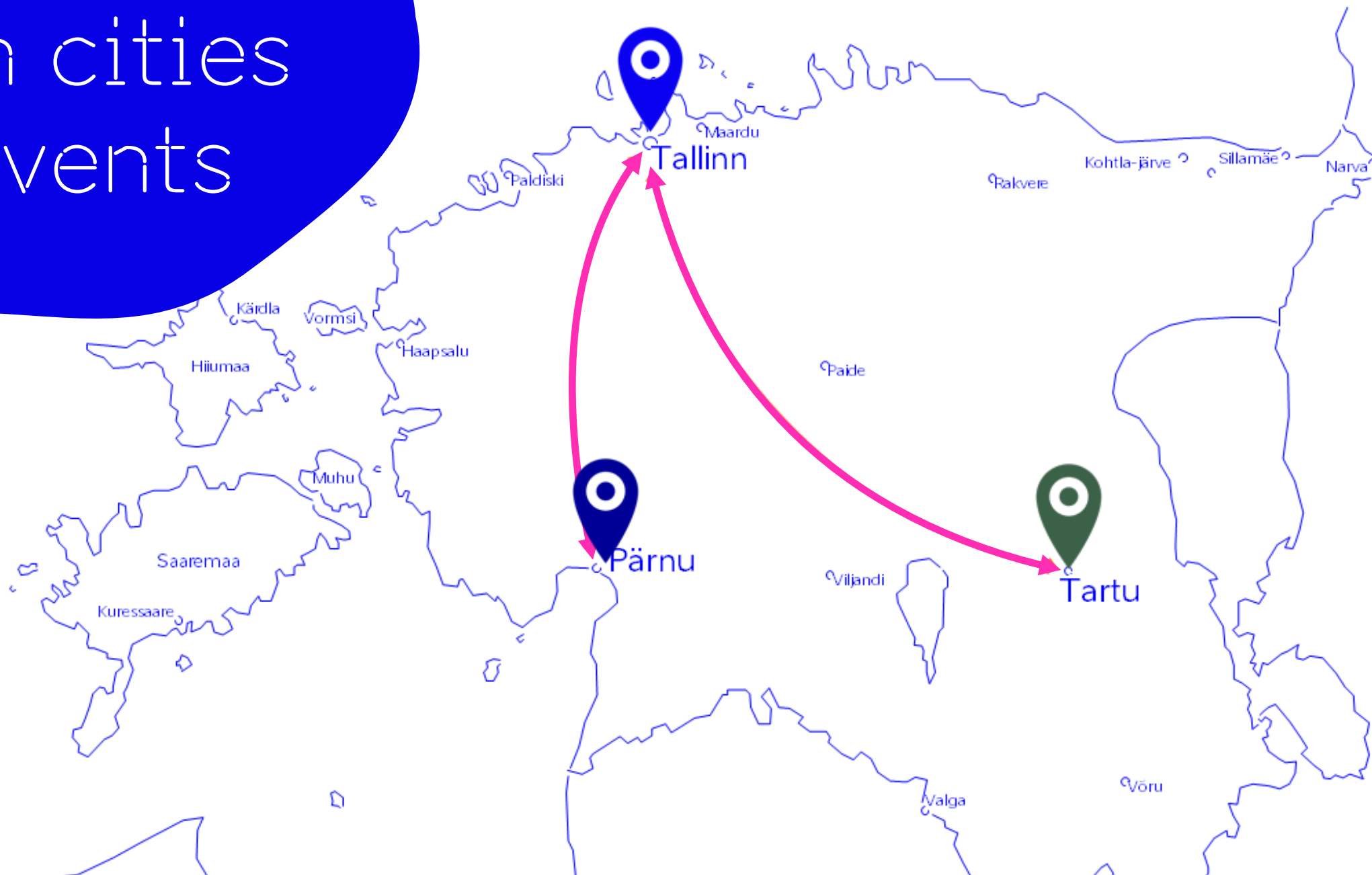


International Tallinn Airport

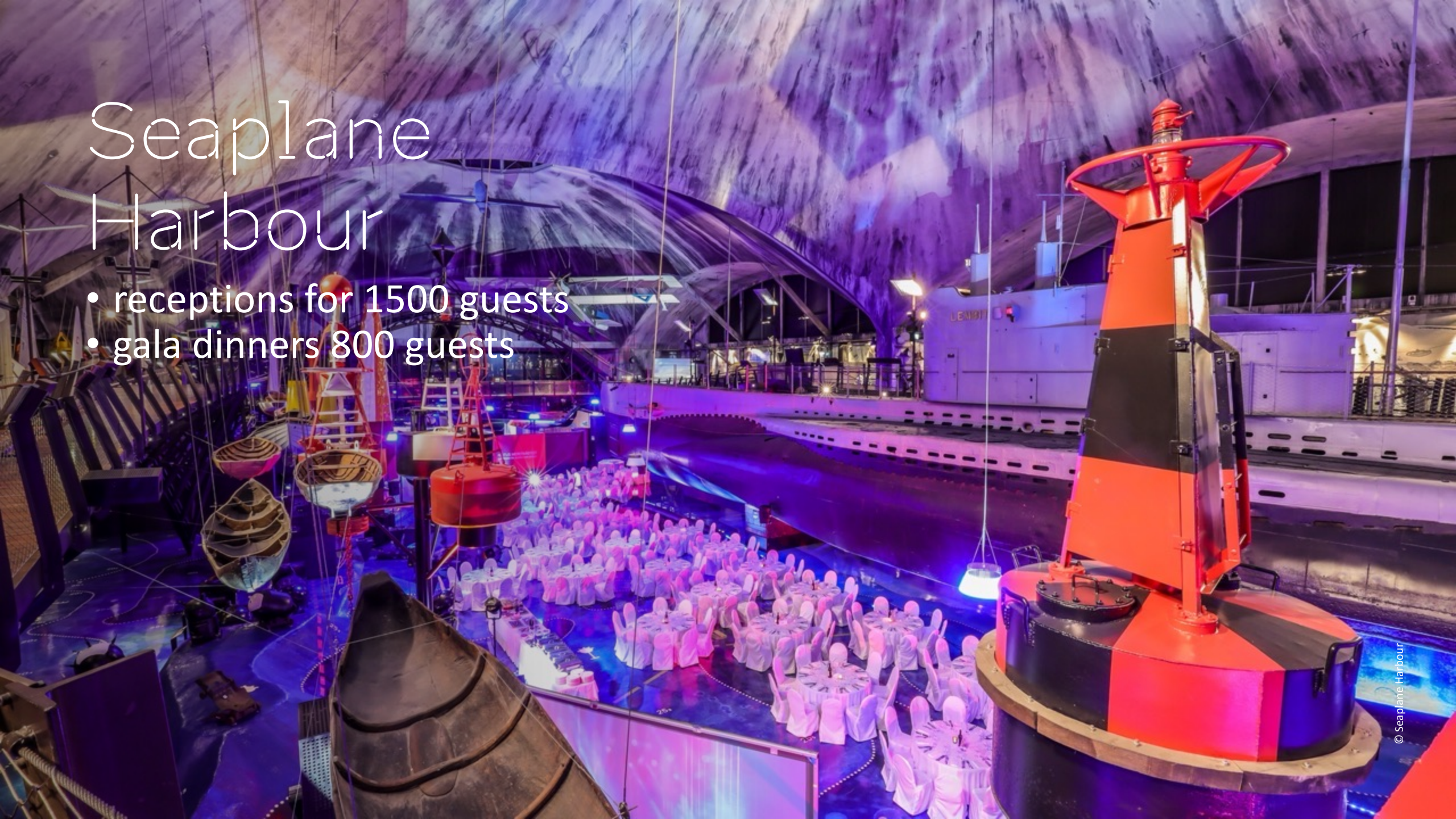

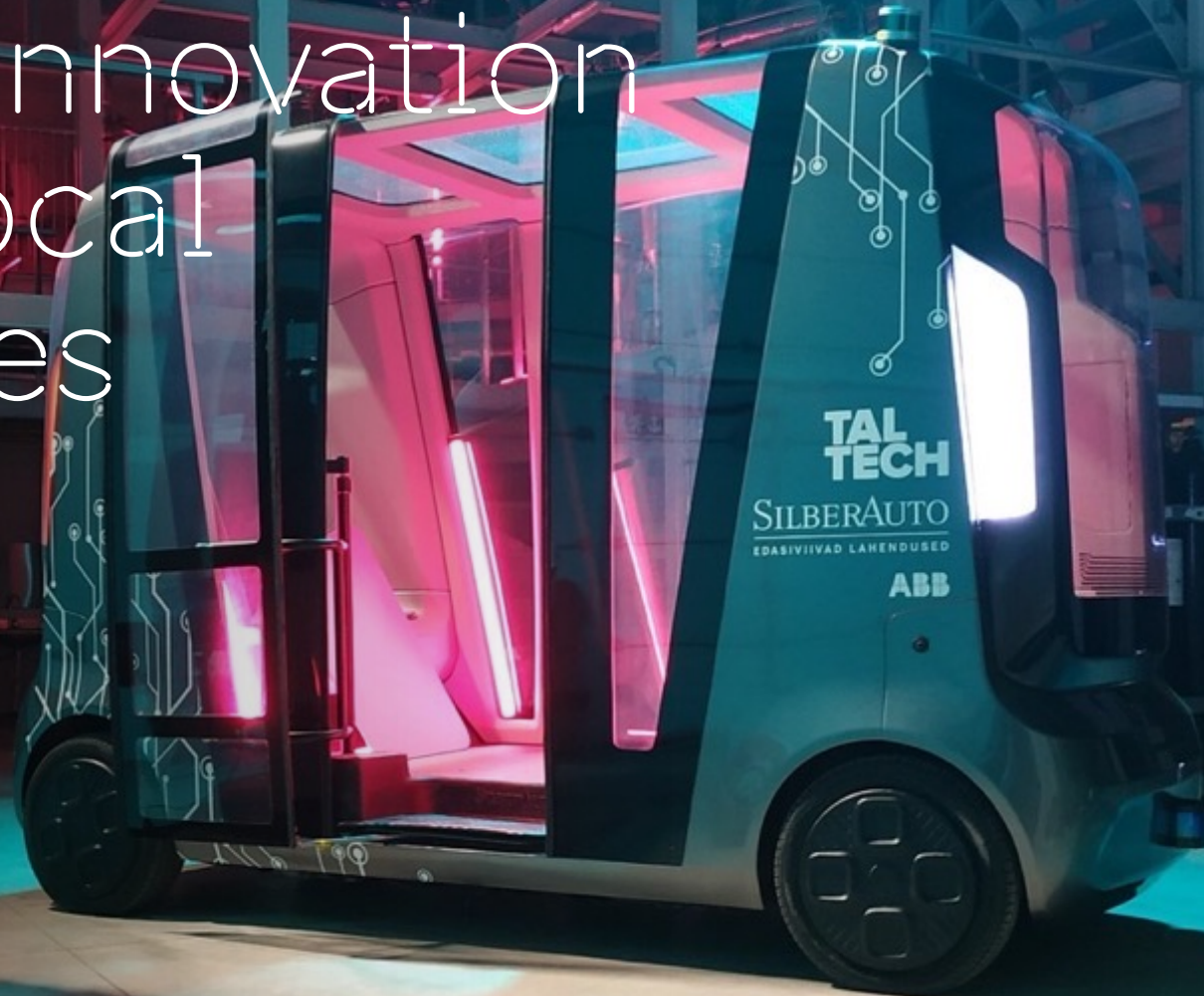
